

## DVD Media to use in LifeLine•DVD

### Use DVD+R discs!

LifeLine•DVD uses single layer (4.7GB) DVD+R media exclusively. DVD+R media provides the highest level of protection for your business critical data. The discs can only be written once and, when stored properly, data can be read for more than 50 years (estimated).

Note that there are many different types of similar appearing media: CD-R, CD-RW, DVD-R, DVD-RW, DVD+R, DVD+RW, DVD-RAM. Only single layer (4.7GB) **DVD+R** can be used in LifeLine•DVD.

DVD+R discs are readily available from office supply stores such as Staples and OfficeMAX, from electronics retailers such as Circuit City, Best Buy, and Radio Shack, from Internet sites such as Amazon.com and Buy.com, and from many other sources. Be sure to use high quality single layer (4.7GB) DVD+R discs.
